



## Notes for authors for publishing technical articles

The technical magazines **photonik** and **laser+photonics** are targeted at scientists, engineers, developers and technicians in industries and application areas involved in optical technologies. The published articles should provide a broad readership with technical information,

- by explaining instruments or phenomena which our readers encounter in their daily work,
- or by presenting new ideas or concepts that are helpful to solve problems in photonics,
- or by explaining procedures and methods that can be applied directly in workshop or laboratory practice.

The articles should have an educational character, i.e. they should help to understand the working principles of photonic systems and/or underlying principles of methods applied in industries involved with photonics. **Emphasis is to be laid on technological principles, rather than on details of a specific product.** 

## Manuscript guidelines

- Publications are normally limited to 3, max. 4 printed pages including figures, accordingly 1500-2000 words (ca. 10.000 15.000 characters incl. blanks).
- Figures (images, drawings, graphs, etc.) are recommended (about 2 images per page). Please send image data files separately from the manuscript. Just provide captions in the text, and name the corresponding image files e.g. "Fig\_1.jpg" (or \*.tif / \*.gif / \*.bmp / \*.eps / \*.pdf / ...) etc.! Captions should be kept as short as possible. Detailed figure explanations and discussions should be embedded in the body text accompanied by a reference to the respective figure.
- The articles should commence with an abstract (summary of key points or also triggering interest in further reading) and include a summary
  or conclusions.
- Literature references and if applicable a list of references with hints of further reading to the specific topic are desirable.
- As contact person the main author (or another person) is named at the end of the article, with address, phone, fax, email, internet, and preferably with a portrait photo.

## **General conditions**

- Articles in **photonik** and in the three times a year released special heading **biophotonik** are published in German language. A selection of these articles are published as English reprints in **laser+photonics** ("Best-of-Edition").
- A manuscript for one out of the 6 annual issues of **photonik** or one out of the 2 annual issues of **biophotonik** should be submitted corresponding date arrangements, but not later than the deadline of the edition. The common revision has to be finalized till the closing date. You can find all fixed dates for the editions in the Media Kit at <a href="https://www.photonik.de/mediaservice">www.photonik.de/mediaservice</a>.
- Editing is carried out in MS Word in turn with the author(s), using "track changes". The following article layout is based on the style guide of
  photonik editorial office.
- In the case of English articles it should be coordinated with the editorial staff early in advance if the translation is provided by the author or executed by the editorial staff.

Submission of an article implies that the author agrees that her/his contribution might be edited for technical correctness and clarity of presentation. In some cases - and only with the author's prior permission - it might be helpful to have the manuscript assessed by a third party person who is especially familiar with the subject of the article.

No royalties or provisions will be paid, nor shall any charge apply, in case of publication. By accepting the manuscript, the right of publication is subrogated to AT-Fachverlag GmbH as well as the rights to translate, reprint, store electronically in archives, create offprints, photocopies, microcopies, and the like.

Articles submitted must not have been published previously, and may not simultaneously be submitted or published elsewhere, also not with closely similar content.

After publication in the magazine, authors receive a complimentary authors-copy pdf-file of their article. Technical articles are available as a free download from photonik, biophotonik an laser+photonics for registered readers.
